

Broadening Horizons Scholarship

<p>Broadening Horizons Scholarship</p>	<p>The Broadening Horizons Scholarship is for students in the Diploma Program. The scholarships are intended to create opportunities for students to broaden their experiences and enrich their cultural and social capital before proceeding to study at UWS.</p> <p>The scholarship will provide students with the experience and opportunity that will extend the limits of their world. Destinations will reflect the UWSCCollege partnerships and current and proposed transnational activities. It is anticipated that these experiences will evolve as part of an international study program in countries such as Kenya, Japan and the UK.</p> <p>If you started your course at UWSCCollege in 2013 or 2014 and will finish in the minimum time by June 2014, you may be eligible.</p>
<p>Eligibility</p>	<p>To qualify for a Broadening Horizons scholarship you must be:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. an Australian citizen or permanent resident 2. enrolled in the UWSCCollege Diploma Program 3. resident in Greater Western Sydney 4. aged 18 years or older, and 5. in good health*. <p>Applicants must have passed all units undertaken at the time of the awarding of the scholarship and must be making satisfactory academic progress in units currently being undertaken.</p> <p>*Note: any medical conditions must be well managed and the student is able to obtain travel insurance.</p>
<p>Other considerations</p>	<p>The recipient should not normally hold any other Australian scholarship or award except with the permission of the Selection Committee.</p> <p>Scholarship recipients will be required to meet partial costs of their trip in addition to any expenditure on items of a personal nature.</p>
<p>Awarded</p>	<p>Scholarships are announced in September and awarded at the graduation ceremony held in November.</p>
<p>Course</p>	<p>Any UWSCCollege Diploma</p>

<p>Benefits</p>	<p>Travel and accommodation expenses determined by UWSCCollege</p>
<p>Duration</p>	<p>Up to 14 travel days</p>
<p>Application and Selection</p>	<p>In their application students are required to submit information or evidence which demonstrates fulfilment of eligibility criteria points 3 and 5, and:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. explains the effect that such an opportunity may have on their personal growth and on their educational outcomes 2. demonstrates that they have undertaken some brief preliminary research on the destination country as advised by UWSCCollege, and 3. outlines a project which they will complete as part of the fieldwork. This project must be approved by the applicant's Curriculum Coordinator. The project will align with their course learning outcomes, graduate attributes or the learning outcomes of a specific unit in their course. This should be specified in the outline of their project. The project outline should be limited to approximately 500 words. <p>Note: criteria (1) may be included in the response to either (1) or (3)</p>
